- Always be positive. Never shout at or ridicule the players.
- Respect players' efforts regardless of whether we have won or lost.
- Show respect for the opposition and officials.
- Keep winning and losing in perspective with personal challenge and enjoyment.
- The use of members from other teams is strongly discouraged unless necessitated by injury or unavailability.
- Play hard but play fair.
- Read and understand the players and supporters code of conduct documents.
