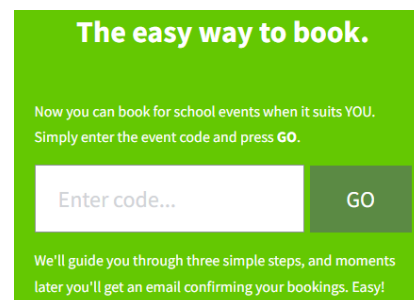
As we are in the Orange settings, please observe the requirement that visitors wear masks as the teachers will too. Masks will be available at reception.
